To secure your place, a deposit of \$250 (plus GST) is required immediately, with the balance of \$2,250 (GST exempt) payable by February 10th 2010. Entry fee does not include accommodation, fuel or meals. Meal money will be advised closer to the event.

In keeping with the Variety Road Event ethos, the 4WD Trek is not a race. It's about travelling to remote and beautiful places, with friends, who share your love of the great outdoors and 4WD driving. Your involvement will also ensure that Special Needs Children receive much needed funding to help them participate in some of life's experiences that we all take for granted.
