1) **Entries:**

2) **Accommodation Bookings:**

For those of you who have not yet done so please book now! Accommodation, particularly in some of the smaller towns is starting to tighten up, so, get in now to avoid missing out.

3) **Meal Money:**

Meal costs have been finalized at Adults \$365.00 and Children \$335.00 which is pretty much in line with last year. This covers all meals except breakfast and lunch on Day 4 the lay day in Dubbo.

Please be sure to advise Elyce of any special dietary requirements,
Meal money is due payable no later than Friday March 5th

4) Day 4 Dubbo Lay Day:

We are putting together a deal to enable every-one to visit the Western Plains Zoo. So that we do not overbook and consequently purchase entries that will not be used please advise Elyce if you do not wish to visit the zoo.

5) Crew and Medical Forms:

Are accompanying and need to be completed and returned to Elyce as soon as possible.

6) Windcheaters and Plaques:

As in past years additional windcheaters and plaques will be available for those who want them.

Costs are: Windcheaters: Adults \$37.50
Kids \$28.50

Plaques: \$35.00

7) Mobile Workshop Day:

Will be Saturday February 27th at the usual location of Volksrepair 11 Earl Street, Airport West.

The Start:

Will be at Waterfront City, Docklands although the exact time and place is yet to be confirmed and will be advised in a later newsletter.
